### FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 151

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 151 will hold a regular meeting on Monday, February 22, 2021, at 2:00 p.m., by telephone conference at (1-888-363-4734), Access Code (8706826), to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Comments from the public.
2. CONSENT AGENDA: The following items are considered routine by the Board and will be enacted by one motion. No separate discussion will occur on these items unless a Board member so requests, in which event, the item will be removed and placed on the Non-Consent Agenda.
  - a. approve minutes;
  - b. garbage collection and recycling services;
  - c. financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of bills, budget comparison, and review of investments;
  - d. discuss Association of Water Board Directors winter conference and authorize attendance at summer conference;
  - e. approve Annual Report and authorize filing of same in accordance with the District's Continuing Disclosure of Information Agreement and as required by SEC Rule 15c2-12;
  - f. annual Review of Procedures for Continuing Disclosure Compliance;
  - g. tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills;
  - h. maintenance and mowing of District facilities, environmental monitoring of facilities, fees for violation, and hearing and opportunity for appeal for withholding tap service for nonpayment of backcharges;

  - j. fire protection services matters, including maintenance of fire station.
